Collector Road Phase III (Hewatt-Parkwood-Britt)

The sanitary sewer system is up and running. Gwinnett County's DWR Director Rebecca Shelton shared that the system replaced the old privately owned sewer system. This is great news for the residential and business community.

The roadway is expected to be completed in November 2025. ER Snell is the general contractor for the project, and has made every effort to work with the community and the businesses as well. Some of the landscape and sound barrier pylons are in place and roadway work continues.
